Re-Enrollment - due February 28

It is officially that time to re-enroll for the 2021-22 School Year. Here is what to expect:

- To complete re-enrollment the following is due on Sunday, February 28, 2021:
 - Signed Contract
 - o \$250 deposit per family
 - FACTS Payment Plan set up for the 2021-22 School Year
- The enrollment deposits are Non-Refundable but are considered the first portion of your tuition payment for the 2021-22 School Year.
- There will be a \$100 late fee for enrollments completed after 11:59pm on Sunday, February 28. Additionally, there will be another \$100 for enrollments completed after 11:59pm on April 30, 2021. Late Fees do not count towards tuition payments.
