This Friday, May 4, our school community will formally begin its month long devotion to the Blessed Mother with the time honored Catholic tradition of the May Procession and Crowning of Mary. The procession will take place at 8:45am followed by the Mass and Crowning of Mary at 9:00am. On this day, everyone in the school will help to honor Mary in the following ways:

- Second Graders should wear their First Communion outfits if they received their First Communion or dress up in their Sunday Best.
- Eighth Graders should all be dressed in their Sunday Best. .
- The rest of the students should wear their dress uniforms. For girls this means their skirts or jumpers. For boys this means pants. Older boys should wear ties.
- All students should bring a flower to honor Mary. These flowers will be collected during homeroom and gathered in vases to be placed around the statue of Mary during the ceremony.

Lastly, we invite all parents and family members to come and participate in Honoring Mary.
